Animals & allowed cruises



Only dogs or cats in good health will be accepted at Cunard. No other animals will be allowed.

The route allowed to travel with your pet will be the Transatlantic Crossings whose port of embarkation or disembarkation is:

- Southampton
- New York
- Hamburg

***This service will not be offered in: Southampton - Ft. Lauderdale or viceversa, Ft. Lauderdale - Nueva York or viceversa, or any other non-transatlantic crossing.*



Kennels



Kennel sizes are:

- 12 lower kennels:
6 (H. 92cm D. 90cm L. 76cm)
6 (H. 92cm D. 88cm L. 76cm)
- 12 upper kennels
6 (H. 69cm D. 90cm L. 76cm)
6 (H. 69cm D. 88cm L. 76cm)

2 kennels may be opened up to accommodate larger animals. Guests are charged per kennel.

Dogs must have their own kennel and cannot share a kennel with other dogs, cats are allowed to share a double kennel with another cat.

***Please, keep in mind that there is no veterinary service on board.*





Restrictions

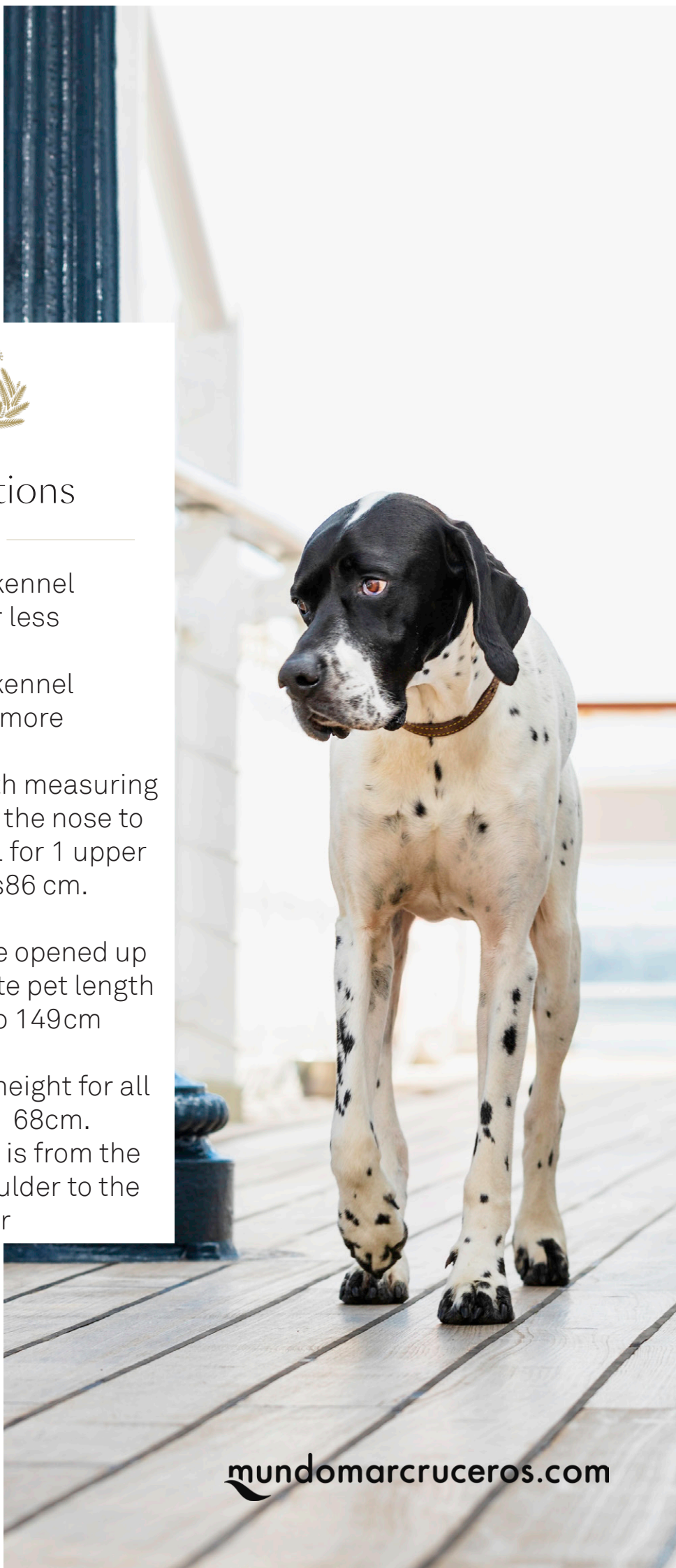


- Upper kennel
11 kg or less
- Lower kennel
12kg or more

Maximum length measuring from the tip of the nose to the base of tail for 1 upper or lower is 86 cm.

2 cages may be opened up to accommodate pet length maximum of 149cm

Maximum pet height for all kennels is 68cm.
Measurement is from the top of the shoulder to the floor

We need to have exact measurements when booking to ensure the dog will fit.

Cats who have Feline leukemia or FIV will not be allowed to sail .

Vaccinations & certification



All guests will be provided a guide and all proper paperwork for their particular route of travel, approximately 5 months prior to sailing.

If you are coming from a non-EU country, other than the USA, please be advised that it is your responsibility to check with DEFRA for the requirements to enter the UK.

If travelling from New York to Southampton Or Hamburg, all pets must be:

- Fitted with a microchip
- Vaccinated against rabies and tapeworm
- Issued with an official PETS certificate, official PET passport or 3rd country certificate (provided)
- Tapeworm treatment is required for dogs 1-5 days prior to departure

Cats require two upper kennels \$1600* (This is two upper kennels, one kennel is for the litter box)

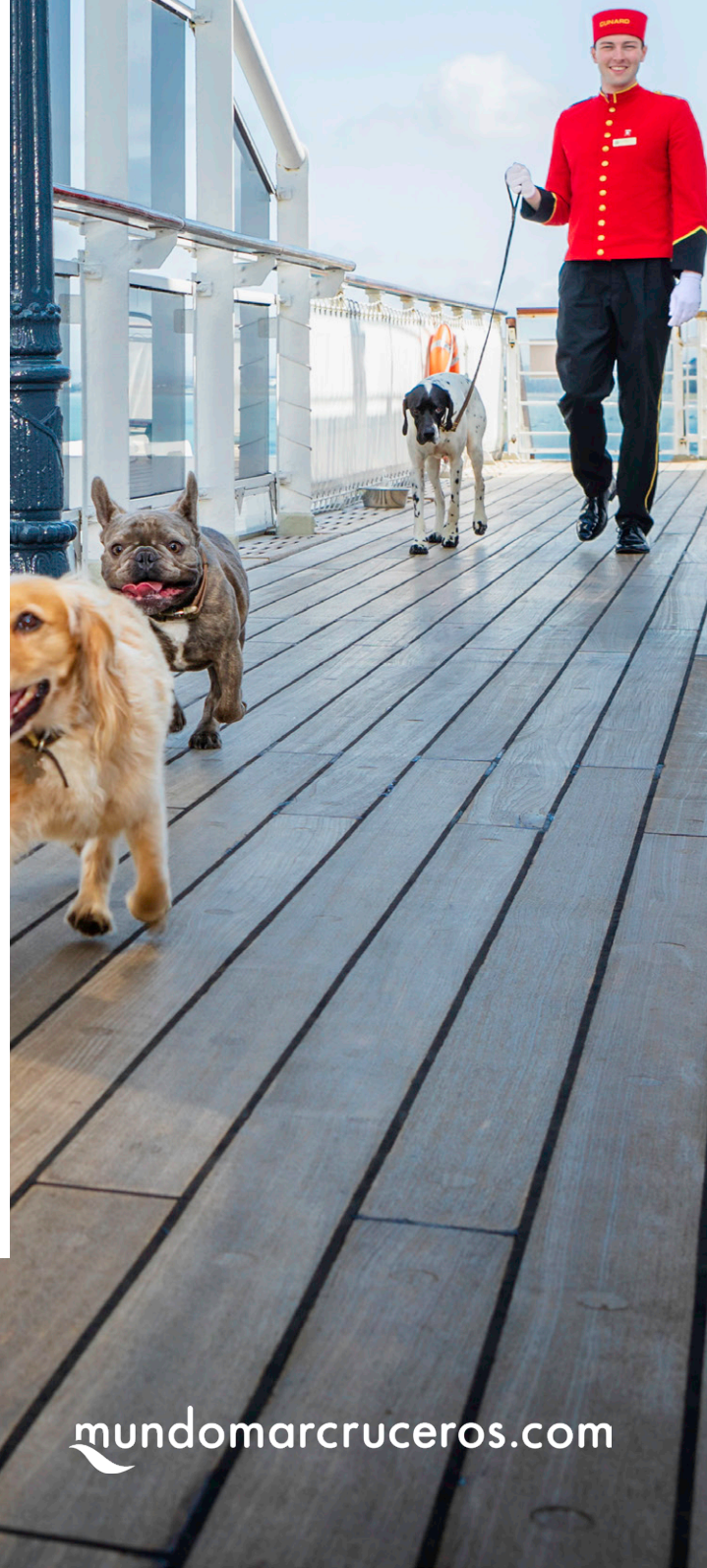
As a cat requires two kennels, there is no charge for a second cat
